FOLLOW PUBLIC HEALTH GUIDELINES FROM OFFICIAL SOURCES

- ✓ Lebanon Transit has adhered to all Center of Disease Control (CDC) and Pennsylvania Department of Health guidelines. This has included actions such as:
 - Sanitizing all vehicles
 - Sanitizing high touch areas of the vehicles throughout the day.
 - Wearing facial coverings
 - Monitoring operators health
 - Making hand sanitizer available for employees and customers.
 - Hatches on vehicles are open (weather permitting) to provided ventilation.
