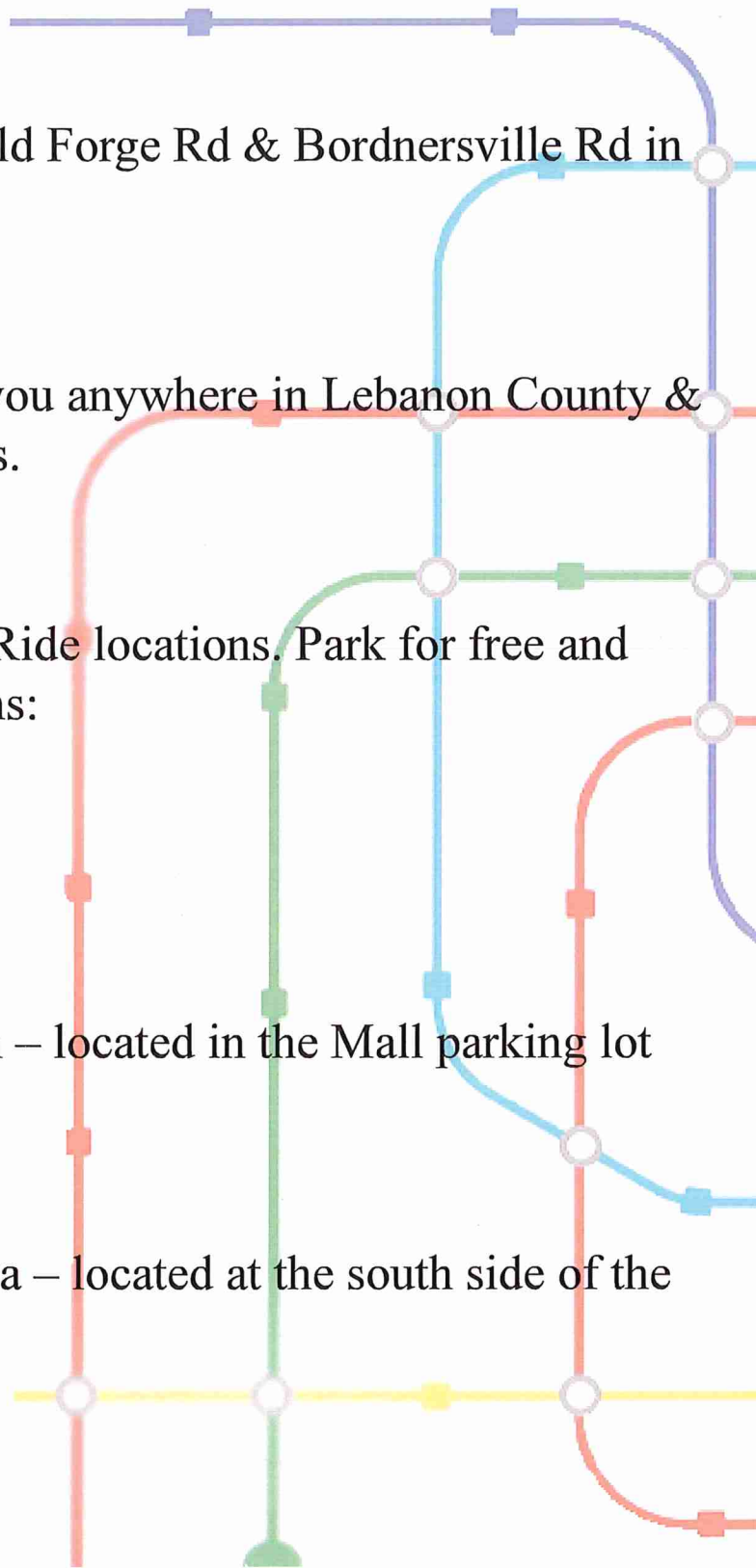

Transfers

1. When boarding your bus let the driver know you need a transfer. This helps you save time and allows the driver to coordinate with other buses.
2. Transfers are 25¢ (1/2 Fare Transfers are 10¢).
3. Transfers are good for the next available run on your desired route.
4. Transfers can only be used at the 7th & Willow St. Downtown Transfer Station.

Seniors**

Customers 65 years and older are eligible to ride Lebanon Transit Buses for free with a Senior Citizen Transit ID Card. This ID is free, but registration is required. Applications can be completed at Lebanon Transit's Main Office, proof of age is required. For more information visit lebanontransit.org or call 717.274.3664.

Students**

Customers who are currently attending grades k-12, an accredited college/university or trade school are eligible for a discounted fare of \$1 each way with a Lebanon Transit Student Fare Card. This fare is in effect from August 15th - June 15th. The card is free, but yearly registration is required. Applications can be completed at Lebanon Transit's Main Office, proof of enrollment is required. For more information visit lebanontransit.org or call 717.274.3664.

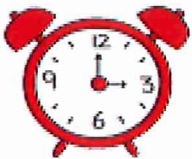
ADA Customers**

Persons with disabilities may be eligible to ride Lebanon Transit buses at half fare with a Half Fare Card. This ID is free, but registration is required. To see if you qualify for the Half Fare Program visit lebanontransit.org or call 717.274.3664.

How To Ride Lebanon Transit Fixed Route



Plan your trip with the free MyStop app, at lebanontransit.org or check your bus schedule.



Be at the bus stop 5-10 minutes early.



Have exact fare or bus pass ready.

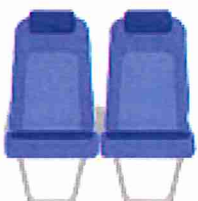


Lebanon Transit is a flag stop service. If you are along the bus route (excluding Express Service), simply wave to signal the driver to stop. The bus will stop at the closest safe spot to allow you to board.

Be sure you are standing on the correct side of the road for your direction of travel.



To choose your stop pull the red cord located over the seats a block before your desired stop.



Remain in your seat until the bus comes to a complete stop.

- ☒ All passengers must be behind the line at the front of the bus.
- ☒ Please stay seated until the bus comes to a complete stop.
- ☒ Please do not eat, drink, smoke or vape on the bus.
- ☒ Please do not litter on or off the bus.
- ☒ Please be courteous.
- ☒ Aisles must be kept clear of strollers, carts & bags.
- ☒ Strollers and carts must be folded and placed under seats.
- ☒ Be mindful of others when using your cell phone or listening to audio. Do not use your speaker setting and please use headphones.
- ☒ Please do not use more than one seat at a time.
- ☒ All wheeled mobility devices are required to be secured while riding the bus.

Lost & Found

Valuables such as wallets, cell phones, purses, etc., left on the bus or at the 7th & Willow St. Downtown Transfer Station can be picked up at Lebanon Transit's Main Office, 200 Willow St., Lebanon. Please call the office, 717.274.3664, to make sure your item has been found.

Items such as clothing, umbrellas, books, etc., can be picked up at the 7th & Willow St. Downtown Transfer Station on Mondays in the Lost & Found Box.

Lebanon Transit Fixed Route Things To Know



All Lebanon Transit buses are equipped with bike racks. Use of the bike rack is free. To use the rack, pull it down into the horizontal positions and secure the front tire. Please return the rack to the vertical position when unloading your bike.

Shared Ride is a curb to curb service that goes anywhere in Lebanon County with no set stops or routes! Go shopping, visit friends and family, run errands, get to medical appointments, the destination is up to you.

Shared Ride also goes to the Hershey Medical Center Campus Monday - Friday at 9:15am, 12:00pm & 3:00pm.

Sign Up!

Registration is required for Shared Ride Service. Registration is free and can be done at Lebanon Transit's office, 200 Willow St. Lebanon, or call **717.274.3664**. Please have a picture ID when applying.

Schedule Your Ride

Shared Ride trips must be scheduled by calling customer service at **717.274.3514**. Next day reservations may be made Monday - Friday from 8:00am - 2:00pm. All other trips can be scheduled up to 2 weeks in advance until 4:00pm.

ADA reservations can be made Monday - Friday from 8:00am - 4:00pm.

Pick up times are estimated. You will be given a 30 minute window in which the van will arrive. Please be ready for your ride.

If customers aren't sure how long they will be at their destination they can call the office and request their return trip when they are ready.

Shared Ride Programs



Seniors - Customers 65 years and older are eligible for the discounted rate on Shared Ride with a Senior Citizen Transit ID Card. This ID is free, but registration is required. Applications can be completed at Lebanon Transit's Main Office, proof of age is required. For more information visit lebanontransit.org or call 717.274.3664.

America With Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA) - ADA is available to persons with a verified disability who reside and travel within 3/4 miles of the Fixed Route bus service. To see if you qualify for the Shared Ride ADA Program visit lebanontransit.org or call 717.274.3664.

Person With Disabilities (PWD) - PWD is available to persons 18-64 years of age with a physician verified disability who travel to and from an area in Lebanon County that is not served by Fixed Route bus service. To see if you qualify for the PWD Program visit lebanontransit.org or call 717.274.3664.

Medical Assistance Transportation Program (MATP) - This Transportation Program is only available for medical purposes and appointments. For more information on the Program visit www.compass.state.pa.us.

Shared Ride Things To Know



If you are unable to take your scheduled trip you must cancel your ride **at least 1 hour prior** to your scheduled pick up



All Shared Ride vehicles are accessible.



Customers are allowed up to 3 shopping bags or small utility cart per trip.
