TRANSPORTATION FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES (PWD)

Lebanon Transit (LT) is here to help you get where you need to go. LT, as well as other public transit systems across the State have established the means to transport anyone, regardless of disability.

LT will provide service to anyone eligible for Persons with Disability Program (PWD). To be eligible for The Persons with Disability Program (PWD), your origin or destination must be outside $\frac{3}{4}$ miles of a Fixed Route bus stop.

The PWD Shared Ride Program is designed for transporting persons with a disability ages 18 – 64 to or from an area that is not currently served by LT's Fixed Route Bus and ADA Complementary Shared Ride Services.

To be eligible you must complete a PWD Application. Applications can be downloaded from lebanontransit.org or picked up at LT's Main Office at 200 Willow St. Lebanon, PA. Office hours are Mon- Fri, 8am-4pm. This Application helps verify your status and eligibility for the PWD Program. All information supplied is kept confidential. Attachment F in the Application must be completed by a professional who is familiar with your disability or you must attach a copy of the Notice of Award from Social Security, stating you have a disability. Determination is made within twenty-one (21) days.

Reservation Information

To use the service after you have been approved simply call LT at 717.274.3514. Next day reservations may be made Monday-Friday from 8am to 2pm, all others up to 2 weeks in advance until 4:00pm.

How to Cancel a Reservation

If you need to cancel a reservation, Call 717.274.3514, at least one (1) hour before your scheduled pick up time.

Holidays

Service is not offered on Sundays or on the following holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas.

Fare is based on a one way trip.

Pick-up/Drop off Window

LT's service, like many similar services, operates on the basis of a "window" for pick-up, defined as 15 minutes before or after the scheduled pick-up time. This means the rider must be ready 15 minutes before the scheduled pick-up time.

Personal Care Attendant

The PWD program does not fund a Personal Care Attendant (PCA) or Companion. PCA or Companion is permitted to travel with the client and must pay the Full Fare rate. Additional companions may ride at Full Fare Rate on a "space available" basis.

Respiratory Use

Riders in need of respirators shall be permitted to bring concentrators and/or portable oxygen on the vehicles.

Visitors Policy

Visitors may complete the eligibility/registration package to use the discounted service. If determined eligible, the visitor(s) may make trip reservations, use the service and receive the PWD discounted fares in accordance with the PWD service in Lebanon County.

Origin to Destination Service

LT provides origin-to-destination service (Commonly referred to as "curb to curb") Call 717.274.3664 Monday-Friday, between 8:00AM and 4:00 PM for information.

If you are going shopping, LT allows the customer to bring no more than three (3) bags on the van.

If you are not eligible for PWD Shared Ride, LT offers many other transportation solutions. Call 717.274.3664 Monday-Friday between 8:00 A.M and 4:00 P.M for information.
