

## Shopping Bags

If you are going shopping, you may bring a maximum of three (3) shopping bags or one (1) upright cart on board the vehicle with you.

## Service Animals

You are permitted to ride with a service animal defined as an animal “individually trained to work and/or perform tasks for an individual with a disability.”

## Ride the Bus

With your Lebanon Transit Senior Citizen Lottery Funded ID Card, you can ride any Fixed Route bus for free! Just show your card to the driver when boarding.

# Program Overview

Lebanon Transit offers a Shared Ride service. In most cases you will ride with others, and other passengers may be picked up and dropped off before you reach your destination. The trip may take longer than if you were going by yourself and you should plan accordingly.

The service provided is “curb-to-curb,” and all Shared Ride vehicles are equipped with wheelchair lifts. Drivers will assist passengers on and off vehicles, as needed. Travel for any purpose inside Lebanon County or to medical appointments at Hershey Medical Center campus.

You must be registered with the Shared Ride Program before using our services, and advanced reservations are required.

**Persons aged 65+ can sign-up for a free Senior Citizen Lottery Funded ID Card to receive a reduced fare for Shared Ride services.**

# Program Features

## Service Area

Shared Ride service is available to any destination for any purpose - medical, family, leisure, recreation, etc. - inside Lebanon County. We also make three (3) scheduled trips each weekday to the Hershey Medical Center campus.

## Service Hours

### **Lebanon City**

**Mon. - Fri. 8:00 AM - 5:00 PM**

**Saturday 8:00 AM - 4:00 PM**

### **Lebanon County**

**Mon. - Sat. 8:00 AM - 3:30 PM**

## Reservations

Trips can be reserved up to two (2) weeks in advance and no later than the day before by 2:00pm.

If reserving a Monday appointment you must call to make your reservation by 2:00pm the Friday before.

## Cancellations

Call 717.274.3514, at least one (1) hour before your scheduled pick up time to cancel your reservation.

## Pick-up Window

At the time of reservation, you will receive a 30-minute pick-up window, defined as 15 minutes before or after the scheduled pick-up time. You must be ready to travel at the start of that window.

## Fares

With a free Senior Citizen Lottery Funded ID Card, your fare co-pay is **\$2.50 per one-way trip**, regardless of distance traveled.

General public may ride at full fare, based on distance traveled:

- **0-5 miles:** \$19.00 one-way
- **5-10 miles:** \$22.00 one-way
- **10+ miles:** \$26.00 one-way

## Holidays

Lebanon Transit does not operate on Sundays or on New Year’s Day, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, and Christmas.
